

## English

During this topic we will be writing for different purposes. We will write poetry and will move onto writing our own diary extract from the Fire of London! We will learn about the 4 different sentence forms and use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify.

Phase 6 phonics will continue, where we will be learning a variety of different suffixes. (e.g er, est, s and es).

## Religious Education

Our focus this term will be Incarnation. We will be asking the question, Is Christmas for everyone? (Secular Christmas) and thinking about what it was special about Jesus birth.

## PSHE

We will be thinking about getting on and falling out with a focus on bullying. We will also be learning about 'Being Healthy and Keeping Safe' and what it means to be healthy, including hygiene, eating and exercise.

## Mathematics

We will be continuing to develop our understanding of addition and subtraction. We will add two 2 digit numbers which involves exchanging, begin to understand commutative law and start solving problems while explaining our reasoning. Towards the end of term we will be looking at money, recognising the different symbols, finding different combinations that equal the same amount and solving simple money related problems.

## Science

We will continue to work scientifically by observing and recording investigations. We will be learning about plants and how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will find out the requirements of plants for germination, growth and survival. We will also look at the process of reproduction and growth.

## Humanities
