

## English

Year 3 will be exploring a range of Roald Dahl books over the term, listening to and discussing a wide range of fiction and asking questions to improve our understanding of a text. In our writing, we will be focusing on pronouns, fronted adverbials and subordinating conjunctions to extend our sentences. We will also be thinking carefully about what a sentence includes. We will progressively build a varied and rich vocabulary to include in our writing.

## Science

Year 3 will be exploring Rocks and Soils in Science. We will be identifying, classifying and comparing types of rocks. We will investigate soils and what they are made from. There will also be opportunity to look at fossil formation.

## Creative Arts

We will be working on our Remembrance poppy project, creating artwork based on Van Gogh and Georgia O'Keefe and creating textile poppies.

In Music, we will be practising our singing skills. We will learn how music tells a story by varying speed, rhythm, instruments and pitch.

## Religious Education

Year 3 will be learning about Creation and Fall, the goodness of Creation and the mistakes of Adam and Eve.

## PSHE

We will focus on New Beginnings to ensure a smooth transition into Year 3.

## Physical Education

Year 3 will have Gymnastics lessons, focussing on symmetry and asymmetry.

## Games

We will develop ball skills of passing, catching, shooting and defending linking to a number of games.

## Mathematics

We will be looking at place value in depth, thinking about the value of hundreds, tens and ones. We will represent and compare numbers to one thousand. We will order numbers and become confident in counting in 50s.

We will begin to add and subtract numbers mentally including a three-digit number and ones; a three-digit number and tens; a three digit number and hundreds. We will estimate answers and solve missing number problems.

## Humanities

In History, we will look at the life of Roald Dahl using our chronology skills and explore when he wrote his stories. Within Geography, we will carry out a comparison enquiry of locations linked to Roald Dahl's life, thinking about human and physical features. We will also carry out some fieldwork.

## Computing

Year 3 will be focusing on E-Safety, thinking about online research and how to use the Internet safely. They will explore methods of communication and personal information. We will be looking at how to send an email and reply to a message.
