We will distinguish between the language of speech and writing (formal and informal) ensure the consistent and correct use of tense throughout a piece of writing, identify the audience for and purpose of the writing, selecting the appropriate form and using other similar writing as models for their own, organise ideas into paragraphs or sections to support the content of the writing and proof read for spelling and punctuation errors and use the perfect form of verbs to mark relationships of time and cause.

Mathematics

We will multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers, supported by materials and diagrams, read and write decimal numbers as fractions, Solve problems involving multiplication and division, including scaling by simple fractions and problems involving simple rates. Read, write, order and compare numbers with up to three decimal places, recognise and use thousandths, round decimals with two decimal places, solve problems with numbers up to three decimal places and those which require knowing percentage and decimal equivalents.

Science

This term we will understand and explain the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird and describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.
