

## English

During this topic we will be writing for different purposes. We will write poetry and will move onto writing our own diary extract from the Fire of London! We will learn about the 4 different sentence forms and use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify.

Phase 6 phonics will continue every morning, where we will continue learning a variety of different suffixes. (e.g er, est, s and es)

## Science

We will continue to work scientifically by observing and recording investigations. We will be learning about plants and how seeds and blubs grow into mature plants. We will find out what requirements of plants for germination, growth, survival as well as the process of reproduction and growth.

## Creative Arts

In **Art**, We will be designing and building our own 1666 houses and looking at creating fire-work art.

In **Music**, the children will be learning all about music and instruments from the Stuarts era.

We will be developing our understanding about Christmas. We will be learning about the story, and how and why we celebrate it.

## Physical Education
