

English

We will begin by writing a recount about our trip to Drusillas and learn about writing for different purposes.

We will move onto writing using expanded noun phrases to specify. First we will write stories, using 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Catastrophe'. Towards the end of term we will write an information text about the sea-side, focusing on writing in the present and past tense.

Science

We will be focusing on investigative processes this term. We will be predicting, performing simple tests, recording our data and using our observations to answer questions. We will also start thinking about how to keep tests fair and accurate recording.

Art/D&T:

We will be looking at Claude Monet by describing the differences and similarities between different styles and making links to our own work.

Music:

We will play tuned and untuned instruments musically investigating different rhythms, tempos and pitches—continuing our theme of carnival of the animals.

Religious Education

We will learn about the Gospel and how Jesus' life and teachings are still relevant today.

PSHE

We will be learning about changes and what strategies we can use to support us.

Mathematics

We start by learning about measurement focusing on mass, capacity and temperature. We will compare the different units using the $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs. We also will learn about how different shapes can contain different volumes of liquid.

Towards the end of term we will start to discuss and explore place value, focusing on Hundreds, Tens and Ones.

Humanities

This term we will be doing a local investigation of beach holidays of the past. We will be looking at the similarities and differences between ways of life in different time periods. We will also research significant historical places in our own locality.

Physical Education

This term we will be continuing working on our athletic skills in preparation for sports day. We will also be practising our strike and field skills by playing rounders.

Computing

We will start by focusing on E-safety again, to make sure all children have excellent understanding of how to keep themselves and others safe online. We will move onto manipulating content using different software by inputting pictures, using the copy/paste function and saving our work correctly.
