

English

We are going to be looking at a number of new books this term. We will be exploring and retelling the stories, through writing. We will also be using our topic 'Remember Remember' as a hook for our writing. We will be looking at sentence formation and how to write a sentence. In phonics we will be finishing off phase 4 and starting phase 5 which is new vowel sounds (e.g. ay, a-e).

Science

This term we will be investigating plants exploring different types of plants. We will be performing experiments and observing plants in our natural environment and in our classroom. We will be learning about the structure of plants such as different types of flowers and trees.

Creative Arts

This term we will be looking at food. We will be learning how to cut, peel, grate and chop a range of ingredients. We will be learning about food safety and the importance of a good diet. We will also be using our measuring skills when cooking some delicious food!

This term we will be looking at incarnation and why Christmas is so important to Christians.

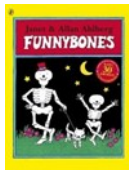
PSHE
