

English

We will be sequencing sentences to write for different purposes, reading our writing to check that it makes sense. We will also be looking at our handwriting, understanding which 'families' letters belong to (i.e. letters which are formed in similar ways) and practising these.

Phase 5 Phonics will continue every afternoon looking at alternative spellings for different sounds such as /ch/ (chain, future), preparing for the screening in term 6. In phonics we will also continue to be looking at our tricky words, such as 'little' and 'people' and practising them both in school and as homework.

Science

This term we will be looking at everyday materials. We will be looking at the difference between an object and the material it is made from. We will also be identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials, looking at their properties and comparing them.

Creative Arts

This term we will be linking art to our RE. We will be exploring press printing, rubbing and stamps to make prints. We will also be experimenting with overprinting motifs and colour.

Religious Education

This term we will be focusing on Judaism and comparing it to Christianity.

PSHE

This term we will be focusing on relationships, looking at our relationships with friends, families and peers.

Mathematics

We will be looking at multiplication and division, counting in multiples of two, five and ten. We will be solving problems using our knowledge of counting in groups. We will also be looking at fractions, using terms such as 'half' and 'quarter'. We will be solving this practically using our learning from term 4 about length and weight.

Humanities—Geography

This term we will be looking at the local area of Eastbourne. We will be using our observational skills to study the geography of the school grounds, as well as comparing Eastbourne to a town in Kenya.

Computing

We will be using computing cross-curricular in our topic learning. We will be using Microsoft Word to manipulate text and pictures, designing posters about Eastbourne and our contrasting town in Kenya.
