

English

During this topic we will begin by writing our own traditional tales based on the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be focusing on using apostrophes for contracted forms and possessions eg. Jack's beanstalk. We will write instructions using subordinating conjunctions, (when, if, that, or because) to extend the length of our sentences. We will also use a range of sentence structures such as commands and questions.

We will also develop poetry writing, looking at creativity as well as commas and noun phrases.

Science

This term we will be looking at animals, including humans. We will notice that animals have offspring which grow into adults. We will find out and describe the basic needs of animals for survival and also describing the importance for humans to exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food and hygiene.

Art and Design Technology

Year 2 will continue to develop their artistic skills with Ms French this term using a range of media and thinking about drawing and shading.

Music:

We will be using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and rhymes. We will explore music that makes us feel happy.

Religious Education

We will be learning about Judaism, thinking about repentance and forgiveness.

PSHE

Our Jigsaw theme this term is Dreams and Goals. The children will set realistic goals and then work through different ways to achieve them independently and as a group.

Indoor PE

We will be learning dance to express and explore different movements. We will create dances with our topic theme.

Mathematics

This term, we continue to build on our understanding of multiplication and introduce division. We will look at statistics, interpreting and constructing simple pictograms, tally charts and block diagrams.

We will also be looking at geometry, identifying the names of different 3D shapes and their properties. Throughout the term we will recap on fundamental place value understanding as well as adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers.

Humanities

We will be linking our learning of Happy Healthy Me with a local walk, identifying and developing our understanding of geographical vocabulary of key human features such as city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.

Computing

This term Year 2 will be introduced to programming using Turtle Logo and Scratch. The children will be able to create, test and debug algorithms, then move onto give instructions and follow Turtle Logo commands.
