

English

Our English is linked closely to our topic this term, where we will be exploring a work of fiction inspired by the English Civil War. We will be looking at how we use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause. We will use the present perfect form of verbs in contrast to the past tense as well as ensuring that we continue to use a wide range of punctuation accurately.

Science

This term our topic in science will be the study of sound. We will be identifying how sounds are made and associating them with something that is vibrating. We will also be finding patterns between the volume of sound and the strength of the vibrations that have produced it.

Creative Arts

We will be improving our mastery of art and design techniques. We will look at using different mediums to imitate historic artworks.

In Music we will be learning understanding how to sing chorally, altering the tone and pitch of our voices to create different moods.

Religious Education

Our topic on Sikhism will explore the Sikh faith in relation to the 10 Guru's, particularly focusing on the story of Guru Nanak. We will also learn about how Sikh's worship and how their beliefs compare to Christianity.

PSHE

We will be focusing on positive friendships and learning how to deal with conflicts.

Humanities

We will be looking at the reign of the Stuarts and Civil War in England. We will develop our interpretations of events in History. We will also be familiarising ourselves with the location of British cities and linking this to our class story.

The children will be looking at different sources of information. They will learn to select, use and combine a variety of software using digital services to design and create a range of programs systems.
