

## English

Year 3 will be developing their non-fiction reading and writing through biographies. We will use paragraphs, bullet points and sub headings to organise our writing. We will be reading a variety of plays and then draft, write and perform a play-script in a group. We will end the term looking at how to use fronted adverbials effectively in a piece of writing and continue to add depth and detail to our sentences.

## Science

This term we will be learning all about light, reflections and shadows. The children will be exploring different sources of light and how we need light to see. They will be working scientifically and collaboratively to investigate reflective materials and will be finding out how shadows change with distance.

## Creative Arts

Year 3 will be creating textile Tudor Roses using a range of fabrics, joining techniques and stitches. In Music, we will be visiting a different country each week to listen to its music and then using the different styles to create our own versions.

**Religious Education:** Year 3 will be focusing on Christian Gospel and Salvation. We will think about the actions and teachings of Jesus; his death, resurrection and ascension.

**PSHE:** Our focus is 'Healthy Me'. The children will be learning ways in which to keep fit and healthy as well as identifying things, people and places that they need to keep safe from.

## Physical Education

We will be learning traditional Tudor dances in our PE sessions, thinking about a range of movement patterns.

**Games:** We will be spending some of the term developing football skills as well as having our swimming lessons.

## Mathematics

Year 3 will be learning all about measuring length, drawing on their addition and subtraction skills and making comparisons. We will also be measuring perimeter of simple 2D shapes. We will begin our fractions learning, thinking about recognising, finding and writing fractions of a discrete set of objects as well as counting in tenths.

## Humanities

We will be exploring the Tudor period as a Local History enquiry. We will look into Henry VIII and his six wives and the lives they led through primary and secondary sources. We will research how England changed during the Tudor reign and will be visiting a famous Tudor house towards the end of the term!

## Computing

Year 3 will be inputting their collected data to convert into various types of graphs and chart to present in a PowerPoint presentation.
