Permission for Local Visits and Trips

During your child's time at St John's Meads, there will be occasions when he/she either participates in school trips in the local area, or further afield in connection with certain curriculum subjects or termly topics.

Some trips will take place within the timetable of the school day, while others may mean an early start and/or a late return (normally for KS2 year groups).

We advise parents in advance when trips are planned and, for insurance purposes, request a 'permission slip' for the children to participate, especially when such trips involve coach or mini bus travel to locations outside Eastbourne, or are entirely outside school hours, whether local or further afield.

However, there will be occasions during the school day when a class or classes may walk to places in the local area for activities. To cover all these local visits, we ask parents to complete the attached 'blanket' permission slip and return it to the school office.

Parents will be given advance notice when the children will be going out of school for visits.
