

English

We are focusing on stories about 'Bears' starting with Everywhere Bear by Julia Donaldson. We will be retelling the stories, role playing, investigating characters, creating story maps and focusing on story openers. We will also be looking closely at our letter formation and ensuring capital letters and full stops are being used correctly.

Phonics

We will be focusing on digraphs e.g sh, ch, th, ng, ar and short vowel sounds, whilst revising short vowel sounds.

Science

We will be focusing on seasonal changes in particular Autumn and Winter. Children will learn what the word weather means and find out how different types of weather can be measured. They will explore the signs of Autumn and Winter through nature and wildlife.

Creative Arts

We will be focusing on portraits of ourselves and others. Also discovering the styles of different artists e.g Van Gogh

Forest School

We will be focusing on how to stay safe around the fire and that fire can be used for keeping warm and cooking food. They will sort sticks by size for the fire and will help to prepare a recipe.

Religious Education


This term we will be reflecting on the key influences from God and the Creation Story.

Physical Education

We will be learning a 'Toy Dance' interpreting how toys would move in time to the music. The music and ideas will be based on the Music Box Dance from Chitty, Chitty, Bang, Bang.

Games

We will be looking at controlling and moving objects and focusing on our throwing and catching skills using a range of resources.

Mathematics

We will be focusing on place value of numbers. This is looking at the values of the digits within the numbers up to 100 and beyond. We will use these skills to help the children with their addition and subtraction skills using resources such counting bears, counters and multilink. We will also be looking at patterns, in particular, repeated patterns.

Humanities

This term will be a History focus. We will be finding out about popular toys through the 20th and 21st century. Children will think about their current favourite toy before moving on to look at toys which were popular when their parents and grandparents were young. They will identify change and recognise how this influences them today

Computing

We will be introducing E-safety to the children. We will be looking at how to use computers and the internet safely and what things they are to be aware of. We will also be highlighting what to do if a child comes across anything inappropriate online.
