Religious Education

In RE this term, the children will be exploring two topics. First "The People of God" reflecting on the question "How can following God bring freedom and justice?" and will be looking at Old Testament texts about God and His people to identify and discuss ideas about freedom and justice and explore how Christians apply these ideas today.

Second "Incarnation" reflecting on the question "Was Jesus the Messiah?" Examining Gospel and Old Testament prophecy texts to understand the idea of Jesus being a saviour sent from God and if true, what difference that might make in people's lives.

PSHE

This term we are 'Celebrating difference'. We will be learning about different perceptions and about the concept of 'normal'. We will be thinking about how having additional needs could affect someone's life, considering our attitude towards others.

Science

We will be continuing to investigate the human body. This term we will be learning about the digestive system, the lungs and the role they play in the body. Children will develop their scientific enquiry skills through carrying out practical investigations. They will learn to analyse and interpret data and graphs in greater detail.


English

We will be 'igniting writing' by reading 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. We will explore how authors write in the 'voice' of their character, and clarify the difference between formal and informal styles (including the use of the subjunctive form and modal verbs). We will be writing formal non-fiction reports, and both formal and informal letters. Also, we will be using the active and passive voice in our sentences, and experimenting with using relative clauses to add extra information about people and places. We will continue to refine our use of advanced punctuation.

Creative Arts

In **Art and DT**, using the theme of 'make do and mend', we will be developing our sewing skills.

Physical Education

We will be learning about different dance styles that were popular before and during the wartime period. We will also be focusing on netball and using this to develop ball handling skills.

Mathematics

The main teaching focus this term is developing our knowledge and understanding of fractions. We will be using all four operations with fractions, ordering and comparing and finding equivalents. Fluency will be addressed through regular practice of times tables, converting between units of measure and making sure we can under-

Humanities

We will be learning about different sources of information and carefully considering and evaluating their reliability. We will consider causes and effects of key events during World War Two, and explore how this affected individuals across Europe as well as in our local area. We will also be learning about significant individuals and significant turning points in history

Spanish

Children will learn Spanish pronouns and understand the concept of verb conjugation. Children will learn the conjugation of regular verbs ending in -ar, -ir and -er and be able to translate and write short sentences (subject + verb).

Computing

This term our focus is on using and creating excel spreadsheets so we can work smarter not harder! We will be inputting formula to create function machine and capturing data.
